Get acquainted.

1. Spend some time getting acquainted.
2. What city were you born in?
3. What is your earliest memory?
4. What is your full name? Do you know why your parents chose that name for you?
5. What are your favorite hobbies and activities?
6. What do you want to be when you grow up? What is your dream job?

Faith questions:

- a. What is your favorite Bible story or character? Why? What are some of the details from that story that you remember?
- b. Talk about a childhood Sunday School/Oasis teacher you remember. What about this person made them memorable?
- c. Talk about a time when you felt the presence of God or God's care for you.
- d. Talk about something in life or the world that worries you. How can your faith help that worry?
- e. In what situation would it be the most awkward to talk about your faith? Why?

Questions to ponder:

- a. What is your favorite thing about your family?
- b. What is humanity's greatest accomplishment?
- c. What movie or book characters are you most like? Why?

End by praying together.
