Good Earth Village, and Benton Harbor, MI YouthWorks service trip.**

1. Register by emailing Lindsay Colwell at lindsay@stjohnskasson.org
2. Registration deadline: Sunday, February 26 at 11am
3. Chili will need to be made at home and brought to the church by **11am on the 26th**
4. Bring chili in working electric crockpot(s) or similar devices
5. Make enough chili to serve 16-20 servings
6. Chili **MUST BE COOKED** and **HEATED** to an internal temperature of 165 degrees F
7. During serving, chili must be kept at a minimum of 140 degrees F
8. A person trained in food safety will be monitoring temperatures during the event
9. Please provide a ladle or large spoon to serve your chili if you are able
10. Cheese, sour cream, crackers will be provided by the Children, Youth, and Family Commission
11. Chili samples for judging will be handed out using small Dixie cups
12. Voting ballots will be distributed to guests at the door
13. One ballot per guest
14. Guest can turn in the ballot to get a bowl of chili of their choice
